Michel LUC & J. Basil GOODEY¹⁾: *Hirschmanniella* nom. nov. for *Hirschmannia*.

Dr. J. Heyns has pointed out to us that the name *Hirschmannia*, which we erected in 1962 (Luc & Goodey, 1962) for some species originally in *Radopholus*, is preoccupied by a Crustacean (Elofson, 1941). Accordingly we change the name for the nematode genus to *Hirschmanniella* nom. nov. with the following new combinations:

- Hirschmanniella spinicaudata* (Schuurmans Stekhoven, 1944) n. comb. -type.
- H. gracilis* (de Man, 1880) n. comb.
- H. oryzae* (v. Breda de Haan, 1902) n. comb.
- H. behningi* (Micoletzky, 1923) n. comb. -sp. inq.
- H. zostericola* (Allgén, 1934) n. comb. -sp. inq.
