Les techniques d'exploration de la personnalité dites projectives, ont vu le jour dans les pays germaniques et aux U.S.A. à partir de 1920.

Destinées à l'origine à apporter un complément au diagnostic psychopathologique, leur usage s'est progressivement étendu aux divers domaines de l'application psychologique.

Tres tot, les anthropologues ont intégré ces techniques dans leur approche de la personnalité socio-culturelle, fournissant ainsi une contribution non négligeable à l'avènement de l'ethnopsychologie scientifique.

Les recherches les plus connues ont été conduites par des Nord-Américains, sous l'impulsion du mouvement culturaliste.

Elles concernent principalement des sociétés amérindiennes à divers stades d'acculturation, soit des groupes sociaux situés dans l'orbite économique des U.S.A.

L'apport Européen est plus réduit, les orientations théoriques dans les sciences sociales n'ayant guère favorisé les investigations dans ce domaine.

Il s'en suit que les publications résultant de ces travaux, dispersées dans des revues spécialisées américaines, restent difficilement accessibles au chercheur français.

Cette bibliographie a été établie en vue d'une analyse exhaustive des publications concernant ce thème.

À la demande de plusieurs psychologues, chercheurs fondamentalistes et praticiens nous communiquons un recueil des publications que nous avons dépouillées.
